Citizen Science is scientific work carried out by the general public. Most importantly anyone can become a Citizen Scientist. This is an ideal time of year to take a closer look at what might be living near your home.

All the following species were recorded and photographed in a single afternoon. By photographing species this gives a physical record. This then can be used to identify a species at a letter point when more time for identification is required.
